

BOB PULLIAM SCHOLARSHIP FUND

(Deadline Registration, March 31, 2017)

All children of IBEW Local 22 members in good standing who will graduate from High School in the spring of 2015 are eligible for the Bob Pulliam Scholarship.

This scholarship will be awarded on the basis of academic ability, character, leadership and community involvement. The number, value and distribution of this scholarship shall be a one-time scholarship of \$1,000 to be paid directly to the student’s account that is enrolled in the freshman class at a College or University and is a full-time student carrying at least 12 credit hours.

Interested students should submit to the IBEW Local 22 Executive Board the application below and a list of all school activities, athletics and public service activities in which they participate in along with a list of any awards received. Also, each student must include a copy of their ACT score along with the application. All testing should be completed before March 1, 2017. The winner of the scholarship will be selected on or before May 1, 2017.

The \$1,000 award will be used only for tuition. If the winner accepts another scholarship of higher value, which covers total tuition, this scholarship will be awarded to the next alternate who conforms to the above regulations.
